 1^{st} 'Craeburn Chase the Clouds' (Craeburn Kennels) – A very attractive youngster showing great potential, sweet head and expression, well put together, a bit of a handful, but showed like a trouper. Will be an interesting boy to see in time to come.

 2^{nd} Mirriyuula Worth Every Penny (T&A Jenkins) – Also a lovely youngster showing potential and a positive attitude. Nice head and expression.

 3^{rd} Kollylock Playboy (N Dewley) – Another young fellow with a way to go, but looks to be heading in the right direction.

Minor Puppy Dog

 1^{st} Tyronelea Dark side of the Moon (S Jackson) – A lovely young Tri-colour, nicely balanced throughout with nice sound movement.

 2^{nd} Tyronelea Moonglow (B Hales) – A sable & White youngster, similar in type to the winner, but I preferred the movement of the first placegetter.

Puppy Dog

 1^{st} Burdekin Big Bang Theory (M Woodbury) – A lovely young Tri-colour, with good head qualities and lovely expression, lovely neck, well balanced throughout with good sound movement. Excellent presentation and well handled.

 2^{nd} Swinbrad I Spy a Sinner (Morris & Dyer) – A Sable & White of lovely type throughout, still needs to finish in head, again well presented and well handled.

<u> 3^{rd} Cathkin Song Sung Blue R&L Thams</u> – An attractive Blue Merle of lovely colour, nice head and sweet expression, but lacked movement compared with 1^{st} & 2^{nd} in class.

Junior Dog

 1^{st} Cathkin Alone inth Moonlight (G Jones) – Nicely put together Tri-colour, with nice head and expression, but could have been more masculine. Nicely handled and moved well.

 2^{nd} Albermayne Black Watch (G Gall) – Another nicely balanced Tri-colour, nicely put down and well handled.

 3^{rd} Vedamea Lightening Strikes (B&L Ryan) – Nice smart looking Blue Merle, sound throughout, but a little too strong in head for me.

Intermediate Dog

 1^{st} Caldbeck Apache Blue (J&L Carver) – A very good stylish Blue Merle with lovely head and expression, well balanced throughout and nicely presented.

 2^{nd} Ch. Cathkin Howzat (G Jones) – A very nice Sable with good head and expression, well presented.

 3^{rd} Barcoo Guesswhos Comingtdinner (B Hales) – A good typey Tri-colour, well balanced, moved well, nicely presently and well handled.

Australian Bred Dog – Wow, what a class to assess.

<u>1st & Res Challenge Dog/Runner-Up to Best of Breed - Gr. Ch. Burdekin Buy M Love (M</u> <u>Woodbury)</u> – A lovely older 'classic' Sable & White with super head qualities with lovely expression. Beautifully balanced throughout, extremely well presented and handled. <u>2nd Baqilodge Zero in onme (Smith & Wilkinson)</u> – Another lovely Sable & White of similar

qualities as the winner, but I just preferred the movement of placed 1st.

 3^{rd} Jodivale Storyteller (S Jackson) – Again another nice Sable and White, with quality throughout but I just preferred the heads on the dogs placed ahead of this boy.

Open Dog – Wow, can the classes get any better.

 1^{st} Dog Challenge/Best of Breed/Best in Show Gr. Ch. Kazjs Sir Spence (J & C Mulcahy) – Again a lovely very 'classic' Sable & White with excellent head qualities with lovely expression. Beautifully balanced throughout, again, extremely well presented and handled. He gave me 'goose-bumps'.

 2^{nd} Ch. Kirrieloch Time Lord (S Buckley) – A stylish Tr-colour with lovely head and expression. Well balanced throughout, showed well, moved well and again nicely presented. 3^{rd} Ch. Cathkin Caldy (C&N Roberts) – Another very good 7 year old Sable and White, nicely balanced throughout, would have liked to have seen him in full coat.

A nice couple of dogs, but I preferred the Tr-colour overall, the Sable & White placed 2^{nd} didn't quite have the balance of 1^{st} . Both had nice expression.

Baby Puppy Bitch – Another super class of lovely youngsters.

 1^{st} Swinbrad Jamaica Sensation (V&D Morris) – A lovely sweet feminine Tr-colour with dreamy head and expression. Nicely balanced and moved well.

 2^{nd} Vedamea Walkin on Sunshine (B&L Ryan – A lovely feminine Sable & White with sweet head and expression. Also nicely balanced and moved well.

 3^{rd} Kollylock Most Captivating (N Dewley) – Another good type of Sable & White youngster, but looks a much slower maturer.

<u>1st Jodivale Ruby Tuesday (S Jackson</u> – A very feminine young Sable & White bitch with lovely sweet head and expression. Nicely balanced and moved well and nicely presented. <u>2nd Albermayne Midnight Sonata (J&L Carver)</u> – An attractive young Tr-colour with a good head and expression, nicely put together.

 3^{rd} Kimtash Angel in thnight (R&L Thams) – Another nice young Tr-colour with a nice head and expression, but lacked top-line compared to 1^{st} and 2^{nd} .

Puppy Bitch

 1^{st} Swinbrad Shut up n Do It (V&D Morris) – An extremely attractive Sable & White with lovely head and expression. Very well balanced throughout, moved and showed well. This girl shows plenty of potential for the future.

 2^{nd} Rixown Amelias Dream (H Rixon) – Another Sable & White of nice breed type with good head and expression. Well balanced throughout but I preferred movement of the 1st placegetter.

 3^{rd} Albermayne Swing n Sing (P Worthington) – A sweet feminine Tri-colour, nicely balanced throughout, but very sluggish today.

Junior Bitch

 1^{st} Rixown Its All Gess Work (H Rixon) – Lovely feminine Blue Merle with sweet head and expression, she took my eye immediately she entered the ring. Well balanced throughout, lovely colour and well presented

 2^{nd} Kazjs Dancing inthe Stars (J&C Mulcahy) – A very pretty Sable & White, again with nice head and expression, well presented and nicely handled.

 3^{rd} Vedamea Light my Fire (B&L Ryan) – Again a lovely Sable & White, with good head and expression, just a little strong in head for me.

Intermediate Bitch

 1^{st} Cathkin All That i am (K Shipman) – A very feminine Blue Merle with attractive head and expression, nicely balanced throughout. Showed and handled well.

 2^{nd} Ladevale Just Trinity (T&A Jenkins) – A lovely Tri-colour with sweet head and expression, also well balanced throughout.

 3^{rd} Cathkin Shes a Knock Out (G Jones) – An attractive Sable & White. A lot to like about her overall, a pity about the flighty ears.

Australian Bred Bitch

 1^{st} & Bitch Challenge - Ch. Cathkin Wink na Smile (G Jones) – An extremely attractive Sable & White with good ring presence and sweet feminine head and expression. Nicely balanced throughout, but could be a tad shorter in body for me, lovely size, well handled and nicely presented.

 2^{nd} Albermayne Simply Irrristable (P Worthington) – An attractive Tri-colour with lovely head and expression and also nicely balanced throughout.

 3^{rd} Vedamea Heir All about me (V&D Morris) – Another nice Sable & White with good head and expression, nicely balanced.

 $1^{s\bar{t}}$ Baqilodge Quite So (Ms M Bester) – A nice honest Tri-colour bitch, nice head and expression, well balanced, in lovely coat.

 2^{nd} Vedamea All Ado About You (B & L Ryan) – Also a nice Sable & White, quite attractive throughout, but a little strong in head for me.

 3^{rd} Cathkin Ugiveme Butterflys (G Jones) – A nice feminine Blue Merle, nice head and expression, but a whisper too much 'stop' for me. Nice colour.

 1^{st} Ch. Kollylock Blue Belinda (N Dewley) – Avery feminine Blue Merle bitch with good head and expression, Nicely balanced and beautifully presented.

Veteran (10Yrs & over)

 1^{st} Ch. Rixown My new Charm (H Rixon) – A super 11 year old Shaded Sable and White, again with good head and expression, nicely balanced and very well presented.
